Minimum Required Education:


Must have a Bachelor's Degree from a regionally or nationally accredited college or university with five (5) years active duty law enforcement experience and an advanced certification from the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement Officers Standards and Education (TCOLE); OR have an Associate Degree from a regionally or nationally accredited college or university with ten (10) years active duty law enforcement experience and an advanced certification from the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement Officers Standards and Education (TCOLE). Preferred degree in Criminal Justice.

Minimum Required Experience:

Five (5) years active duty law enforcement experience with Bachelors Degree; OR ten (10) years active duty law enforcement experience with an Associate Degree.

Must have work experience in patrol functions, investigative techniques, budget and personnel management and administration and at least five years of law enforcement supervisory experience required.
