American Heart Association Heartsaver CPR & AED (#3845) – 4 Hours

Course Description: This four-hour course follows the protocol and lesson plan of the American Heart Association including the five links in the adult Chain of Survival: Immediate recognition of cardiac arrest and activation of the emergency response system Early cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) with an emphasis on chest compressions Rapid defibrillation Effective advanced life support and Integrated post-cardiac arrest care.

Certification: All participants will receive the American Heart Association Heartsaver CPR & AED two-year certification - This certification is meant for First Responders.

American Heart Association HeartSaver First Aid (#3830) – 2 Hours

Course Description: This two-hour course follows the protocol and lesson plan of the American Safety & Health Institute including First aid basics, Medical emergencies, injury emergencies, preventing illness and injury, and Opioid-associated life-threatening emergencies.

Certification: All participants will receive American Heart Association Heartsaver First Aid two-year certification.

Stop the Bleed-Bleeding Control training (#4960) – 2 Hours

Course Description: This two-hour course follows the protocol and lesson plan of the Stop the Bleed by the American College of Surgeons Committee on Trauma including learning the ability to recognize life-threatening bleeding and act quickly and effectively to control bleeding once you learn three quick techniques.

- How to use your hands to apply pressure to a wound
- How to pack a wound to control bleeding
- How to correctly apply a tourniquet
- We will also discuss other supplies that could be found on the Texas School Bleeding Control Kit

Certification: All participants will receive the Stop the Bleed two-year certification.
