Course Description: This course is a required course to be completed no later than the second anniversary of the date the officer is licensed effective April 1, 2018 or the date an officer applies for an intermediate proficiency certificate, whichever date is earlier. This course is also required for those applying for license in Texas, which includes out of state officers, military and federal law enforcement individuals. Lastly, this class is required for those wishing to obtain their Mental Health Officer Proficiency Certification.
