<u>Course Description:</u> The School Based Law Enforcement Course is a required course for all school district peace officers and School Resource Officers who are commissioned by or who provide law enforcement at a school district. Upon completion of this course, each student is required to apply for a School-based law Enforcement proficiency certificate per TCOLE Rule: §221.43.

Topics covered:

- 1. Child and Adolescent Development and Psychology (4 Hours)
- 2. Mental Health and Crisis Intervention (4 Hours)
- 3. De-escalation Techniques and Techniques for Limiting the Use of Force (4 Hours)
- 4. Mental Health and Behavioral Needs of Children with Disabilities or Special Needs (4 Hours)
- 5. Restorative Practices and Positive Behavioral Interventions (4 Hours)

<u>Who should attend</u>: Law Enforcement Officers and School Resource Officers who are commissioned by or who provides law enforcement at a school district. Initial completion requirement was for school districts with an enrollment of 30,000 or more students. As of September 1,2019, the enrollment qualifier has been removed (HB 876).
