Gary was a founding member of the Houston Metro ICAC Taskforce and served as its Deputy Commander, and he has extensive training in computer and mobile device forensics and lab management. In 2015, he moved to Harris Co SO to build its first High Tech Crime Unit from the ground up and later became the agency's Director of Information Technology, leading more than 100 employees and implementing one of the largest digital evidence and body-
